Swimming Program

In response to data about drownings and water safety, the Victorian Department of Education have developed requirements for students to achieve the Victorian Water Safety Certificate.

By the end of Year 6, it is anticipated that students are able to demonstrate the knowledge and skills identified in the Victorian Water Safety Certificate (VWSC). The competencies focus on water safety knowledge, rescue skills, survival sequences and the ability to swim a continuous distance of 50 metres.

We have developed a plan for students to participate in swimming or water safety lessons this year in both pool based and classroom based settings. This program will be developed further next year and be scaffolded with the expectation of all students achieving these vital skills. It is essential that all students know how to swim.

Camps and Excursions Payment Deadlines

Our school offers a broad range of educational experiences to complement classroom learning. Our staff do a tremendous amount of work planning and costing these activities to ensure they are successful. As these events are a part of the curriculum, every child is expected to attend.

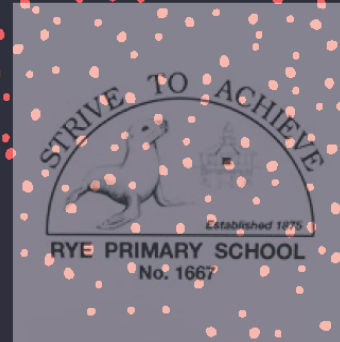
A Special Thank You.....
